

## Notice of Nomination and Election for Local Lodge 701 Vice-President

Pursuant to a voluntary compliance agreement between the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL), Office of Labor-Management Standards (OLMS) and the International Association of Machinists (IAM) Local Lodge 701 (LL 701), IAM Local Lodge 701 will conduct an election on July 10, 2019 for the office of Vice-President for the term ending December 31, 2021.

Nominations will be held at a special meeting on **Friday June 14, 2019, at 6:00 am to 8:00 am and 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm**, and the election will be held at a special meeting on **Wednesday July 10, 2019, at 6:00 am through 7:00 pm**. Both of these special meetings will be held at Local Lodge 701's Union Hall located at 450 Gundersen Dr., Carol Stream, IL. 60188. All special meetings will be held open until every member present before the closing time has had the opportunity to nominate or to vote.

Only members in good standing may participate in the nomination and election process. Eligible members may also participate through absentee ballot as set out in this notice.

### CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All nominees must be members of the Local Lodge in good standing for at least one (1) year prior to their nomination and free of delinquency of any nature to any local lodge, district lodge or grand lodge, shall be working at the trade as defined in the IAM Constitution, and to otherwise qualify under the IAM Constitution as well as the Local Lodge 701 By-Laws. Please refer to additional eligibility requirements in IAM LL By-Laws, Article III, Section 3.

### NOMINATION MEETING

- \* Nominations may be made from the floor by a member in good standing.
- \* Members may nominate themselves.
- \* Members who are not present may be nominated, but they must have a letter on file with the Recording-Secretary stating that they will accept the nomination for office.

### ELECTION

Eligibility to vote:

- 1) All members who are in good standing.
- 2) Retired or exempt members and members on indefinite layoff.

### WRITTEN NOMINATIONS AND ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Upon request, members shall be entitled to nominate by mail and/or furnished absentee ballots provided they meet one of the approved reasons on the Absentee Nomination/Ballot request form, which is attached. Members nominating by mail or requesting an absentee ballot may use the form attached or send a letter containing the same information.
