

Mail nominations must be received by the Recording-Secretary no later than the close of business (5 pm) on **Thursday June 13, 2019**. The Recording-Secretary will inform the member by mail within five business days if the nomination has been rejected including the reason for the rejection. Completed absentee ballot request forms shall be received by the Recording-Secretary no later than 5 pm on **Friday June 28, 2019**. Members applying for an absentee ballot shall have their eligibility to vote by absentee ballot determined by the Recording-Secretary before the ballot is mailed. The Recording-Secretary shall within 5 business days of the close of the nominations or receipt of the absentee ballot request, whichever is later, mail either the absentee ballot or a response explaining why the absentee ballot request has been denied.

Protest Procedures

The July 2019 election will be supervised by the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL). Questions must be directed to Election Supervisor Claudia Guerra-Mazur via telephone at 312-596-7165, or email to Guerra.Claudia@dol.gov. In order to be acted upon, protests concerning the conduct of the election must be received by the Election Supervisor, in writing no later than the tenth calendar day following the election.
